



Sri Lanka's High Commissioner to India Milinda Moragoda met with the Deputy National Security Advisor of India Shri Pankaj Saran, today (27) at the National Security Council office in New Delhi.

Deputy National Security Advisor Saran cordially welcomed High Commissioner Moragoda and had an extensive discussion with him.
